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Descaling detergent

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→ DESCRIPTION

Celon is a formulation based on phosphoric acid with a low foaminess, enabling to obtain a descaling solution able to remove inorganic residues from surfaces, a detergent action towards protein dirt and a general biocide action carried out thanks to the presence of cationic compounds.

Celon can be used for a wide range of applications in food industries, beverage bottling industries and in the dairy field.

Celon can be used with dosage and control automatic systems, granting a correct dosage of the formulation.

→ TECHNICAL CHARACTERISTICS

Physical appearance: green clear liquid

pH (1% solution): $2,0 \pm 0,5$

Relative density at 20°C: $1,30 \pm 0,05$

Conductivity 1% sol. at 25°C: 5 mS/cm.

The above indicated chemical-physical data represent the typical product's characteristics drawn from the analysis carried out on the product. These values are not a specification.

→ INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE*

Use **Celon** at variable concentrations between 0,5 and 5% according to the kind of application, contamination degree and quantity of present limescale. The formulation can be used at a temperature between 20 and 70°C. Carry out an accurate final rinsing with drinking-water in order to remove any possible solution residual.

→ FIELDS OF APPLICATION

For the acid cleaning and descaling of closed circuits, CIP plants, tanks and pipes. For the cleaning of milk recovery tanks and milking plants. **Celon** can be used for the washing of steel and plastic moulds in static immersion and tunnel systems.





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→ COMPATIBILITY OF THE FORMULATION

Celon is compatible with most material normally present in food industries, if used according to the producer's indications. Pay a particular attention towards aluminium, copper, zinc-plated iron. Do not leave the static solutions in contact with surfaces for a long time. In case of doubt, carry out a test on the single material before using the product.

→ PRECAUTIONS FOR HANDLING AND STORAGE

Store in the original containers and avoid extreme temperatures. Consult the Material Safety Data Sheet.

→ TITRATION METHOD

Sample: 50 mL of washing solution

Indicator: phenolphthalein

Titration agent: solution of sodium hydroxide (NaOH) 1N

% (v/v) **Celon** = mL titration agent x 0,174

% (w/w) **Celon** = mL titration agent x 0,255

→ PACKAGING

25 kg net drums.

290 kg net drums.

1350 kg net IBC.
