### **"→** TECHNICAL DESCRIPTION

**AEB** produces a **wide range of filter sheets**, enabling **to satisfy all filtration needs in the alimentary field**. They are available in **all the main dimensions** used on the market, with **all porosities** needed to solve all kind of problems related to clarification.

#### **··**→ MAIN FEATURES

- Microbiologically reliable
- The interaction between sieve effect and adsorption is equilibrated, and this enables minimum colour losses
- They are built with **high quality raw materials**, with a low content of transferable ions
- They are food grade and in accordance with international regulations
- They have a **solid structure** and are mechanically stable and resistant
- They are easy to be used and are easily removable from the plate
- In systems with hydraulic closing, they significantly reduce the dripping

#### **··→** COMPOSITION AND STRUCTURE

Thanks to their composition, they can be classified as **depth filters comparable** to a very thick sieve, with very fine channels and infinite ramifications. The ratio empty/full is of about 80%. The liquid to be filtered slowly circulates through these channels. Along their way, solid particles and microorganisms remain trapped in the matrix and the electro kinetic potential, or ZETA potential, supports and completes the mechanical sieve effect through the adsorption.
